Jay Overton is currently the Director of Golf at The Westin Innisbrook Golf Resort in Palm Harbor, Florida. He returned to this position April 1, 2005 after serving as a consultant for Innisbrook and Troon Golf from June 2000 to March 30, 2005. He also participated as a member of the Champions Tour while consulting for Troon Golf.

Jay served as the Head Golf Professional at the Pinehurst Resort and Golf Club from June 1975 through 1977. Jay joined Innisbrook in 1978 as The Director of Golf. He oversaw the golf operation highlighted by 72 holes of championship golf, of which four are award-winning courses, including the Copperhead Course. During his tenure at Innisbrook Jay has served as Vice President of Golf Hosts, Inc. that included overseeing all the Golf Operations of Innisbrook as well as its sister property Tamarron in Durango, Colorado. As Senior Vice President of the Innisbrook Resort from the early 1980's until 1997 Jay's duties included all Golf Operations, Grounds Maintenance, Recreation, Tennis, Pools and all Retail Operations on the resort. In addition Jay oversaw an additional 18-hole upscale public golf course in Sarasota called The Legacy under Troon Golf Management as well as the Eagle's Golf Course and The Lost Oak's Golf Course from 1997 to June 2000.

Jay is also a former PGA Tour player and has been named the 2001 and 2002 Senior PGA Club Professional Player of the year and from 2001 through 2004 during the last three Senior PGA Tour seasons accumulated seven top 10 finishes including a top ten in the 2002 Senior PGA Championship. Jay has competed in 23 major championships including the PGA and US Opens, Senior PGA, Senior US Opens and British Senior Open. He was back to back champion of the Southern Regional Club Professional Championship and two time representative of the PGA Cup Team, a three time North Florida PGA Section Champion, two time North Florida Senior Open Champion, and North Florida PGA Section Player of the Year on many occasions. Jay still holds the PGA Championship 36-hole scoring record (134) for Club Professionals, trailing only Paul Azinger in 1988 at the halfway point at Oaktree.

Jay also created the Golf Instruction Program at Innisbrook known as The Innisbrook Troon Golf Institute, which he developed in 1978. The Golf School Programs offer a yearlong series of comprehensive instruction programs for all levels of play, including a summer program for juniors.

A native of Pinehurst, North Carolina, Jay attended Duke University in 1969 & 1970 on a football scholarship, transferring to Campbell College in Buies Creek, North Carolina where he was an All-American player in 1973 and Co-National Champion, NAIA, Division of College Athletics.

Jay is married to Sally Overton, Administrative Assistant to Asset Manager, at The Westin Innisbrook Resort. Sally started at the resort in 1978 also. They have one Son Jason, 22. Jay is an avid fisherman and enjoys scuba diving as well.
